Behaviorists look at measurable and observable behaviors of a human. A behavior is anything you do or say that can be observed by others. Some behaviors in a classroom can be anything from raising your hand, writing down the answer, or throwing a piece of paper across the room.

## **EXTINCTION AND CONSISTANCY**

Extinction is commonly used by teachers to eliminate mildly unacceptable conduct. It is the withholding of reinforcement such as not delivering attention to a child for some inappropriate action. Extinction is useful for minor problem behaviors maintained by attention or possibly even getting out of classwork as long as you consistently withhold the reinforcement of attention and/or escape from work. Consistency is key to developing good classroom management and developing proper classroom etiquette.
