EFFECTIVE
PRAISE
FOLLOWS THE
IF-THEN FORM

If the student is doing something that you want to encourage, then (and only then) should you praise the student.

EFFECTIVE
PRAISE
INCLUDES THE
STUDENT'S
NAME

When praising a student, using the student's name ensures that you are being specific with who and what you are praising.

PRAISE IS
DESCRIPTIVE

Convince the student that you mean what you say by moderating your tone to convey that you are impressed with the child's work.
